

#### THE OUTSIDER

A man out of this world suddenly wanders onto the stage.

The Outsider is unbelievable and outstanding performance which employs comedy, tragedy and absurd situations to make spectators reflect on the modern man's way of living and alienation from life. "The lovely character of the Outsider and the performance were born when playing with the ideas: How would a naive, childlike character experience the phenomena of the modern world when encountering them for the first time. How would he regard people and their ways and habits, their love and capacity for evil?", Raudaskoski tells. This performance has gathered a great success around the world.

The Outsider is a delightful fantasy for grown-ups where great combination of theatre and film come together by means of magic, technology and clownery. The performance evokes the visual style of the silent films by Charles Chaplin and Buster Keaton, simultaneously taking them into a contemporary format – in full colour and stunning special effects! The Outsider has received many standing ovations for example in Sweden, Lithuania, Italy and in the major theatres in Finland.

#### JANNE RAUDASKOSKI

The author of *The Outsider*, the actor and screenwriter, Janne Raudaskoski, is a Finnish magician and performer. A Finnish and Nordic champion in magic, he has worked as a professional performer since 1997. He has created and carried out two of his own productions which are touring around the world. *The Outsider* (premiere 2011) is targeted for adults and for young people. And a family show *Wally Watthead and his lost glow*. Raudaskoski has The Arts Promotion Centre Finland's Artist Grand for years 2012-2015. Janne Raudaskoski was chosen in 2014 as *The Magician of the Year* by The Finnish Magic Circle.

#### Illusions we want to believe in

'Anyone who blows soap bubbles cannot be all bad.'

This is the motto of Finnish magician Janne Raudaskoski and his hugely popular performance called *The Outsider*.

Raudaskoski's performance is based on expressions and gestures of classic clownery, but his tricks are updated to the age of video screens, mobile phones and wireless technology. The magician successfully plays tricks on his audience using pre-recorded video clips matched so precisely that transitions from one sequence to next can barely be noticed. The pre-recorded sequences enable him to appear as three different characters simultaneously. All this is accompanied by a flock of popes, a gang of children and a flashing airplane flying in circles above the audience.

The rather smartly designed performance advocates messages of love and tolerance. It speaks out against war, the consumption craze and destruction, but always with humour and a playful, light touch. One of the ladies in the audience is also given a very special role in the performance.

The show, built on a foundation of a decidedly humanist ethos, is perfectly timed to the split second, and its message is lightened with a barrage of soap bubbles – where Michael Jackson and his monkeys also appear in a joyful flash.

# Review from Tampere Theatre Festival 2012, one of the most noteworthy European theater festivals

#### "Someone blowing soap bubbles cannot be a bad person"

The Outsider, an experiential theatre performance by professional magician Janne Raudaskoski, has just ended at the Hällä Stage. The audience simply will not stop applauding. We are astounded by the charming performance which is story of the adventures of an extraterrestrial at Tampere.

We are in the cockpit with the extraterrestrial, speeding towards the Earth. We know exactly where we are about to land because the coordinates point us towards Tampere Theatre Festival and the Hällä Stage. After landing we are responsive and ready with our soap water. Let the magic begin!

Actually, nothing should be told of the show; we should not ruin for others the joy of having the same wonderful experiences and surprises that made me rejoice out loud.

But maybe I will still tell you a little something of the charming magic world conjured by Ianne Raudaskoski.

Raudaskoski got the inspiration for his new show when he pondered why the majority of people do not go to the theatre, yet movies have plenty of audience.

He made use of the means he knew well and developed an experiential theatre performance that combines the means of art and technology to attract especially the young people to the theatre.

#### Multiplying magician

The themes Raudaskoski has taken from his environment. Money, love and junk food. Upbringing, consumption and violence. Our spaceman has a lot to wonder about.

Two video screens and a door are all that is needed for the set. Everything else appears on the screen by magic, of course, as the show progresses, like a remote-controlled aeroplane, a streamer storm, a gold glitter rain, and the fruit of a love at first sight, baby Outsider.

The alien played by the magician is multiplied on the screen, and the living actor steps in and out of the video. The same whimsy goes on through the show, only the story changes.

Janne Raudaskoski's Outsider is some kind of a sweet combination of Stan Laurel, Buster Keaton and Charlie Chaplin. Besides the leading role, the magician also does the supporting roles. There is a wide range of characters from a dude in a junk food restaurant to a sassy date and to Michael Jackson.

The script is concise, witty and terribly funny.

In the end we all get to open the soap water bottles handed out to us. Like Raudaskoski says: "someone blowing soap bubbles cannot be a bad person". If your inner child is astray, it will surely return home during a performance such as this.
